St. Catherine of Siena's parents wanted her to get married, but she refused, wanting instead to devote her life as a nun. Her parents finally agreed. At first she lived by herself, but after three years she had a vision in which she realized her life was not to be spent alone in prayer but in helping other people. In those days, Europe was

being swept by the plague. Catherine risked

her life, working as a nurse to help people. Catherine's feast day is April 29 and she is the patron saint of nurses and firefighters.
