Matching Opportunity for Debt Reduction

In 2018, fundraising efforts were successful in financing the elementary school project without a need for using any debt. With encouragement from contractors, who correctly projected that building costs would greatly increase, the school took a leap of faith and built the shell that would house the middle school wing and science lab. Due to the generosity of the contractors and other school benefactors, a portion of this project was funded, and a portion was financed. The financing allowed us to complete the 7th and 8th grade classrooms for the start of the 2019-2020 school year. A school family has generously offered to match up to \$100,000 for debt reduction. A parish family has donated the first \$50,000 toward the match. If the remaining \$50,000 is matched, this amount, along with money in the school's building savings account, has the potential to retire the debt owed on the entire school building project fifteen years earlier than planned! Last year at this time, the building loan was \$883,971. Today it is nearly half that at \$465,653! Praise God for the generosity of so many.
