SCHOLARSHIP: When Karen Edmundson's dad died in 2003, her family asked that donations go toward a scholarship to All Saints Catholic School in his name. Because of Adrian Nuxoll's lifelong active involvement with the Knights of Columbus at the local, state and national level, the scholarship is awarded to a child who will be in grades K-8 next year, whose father or grandfather is/was involved in the KC's. The scholarship is available to help pay K-8 tuition for any member of the child's immediate family to All Saints Catholic School for 12 months following the award. It is not a reimbursement for tuition already paid.
