

## Nuxoll Family Memorial Scholarship

When Karen Edmundson's dad died in 2003, her family set up a scholarship to All Saints Catholic School in his name. Because of Adrian Nuxoll's lifelong involvement with the Knights of Columbus, the scholarship is awarded to a child who will be in grades K-8 next year, whose father or grandfather is/was involved in the KC's.

The scholarship is available to help pay K-8 tuition for any member of the child's immediate family to All Saints Catholic School for 12 months following the award. It is not a reimbursement for tuition already paid.
