Catholic Quiz Corner

On Palm Sunday the people of Jerusalem greeted Jesus with the words (a.) “Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace among those whom he favors” (b.) “Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!” (c.) “Lord, I am not worthy” (d.) My “Lord and my God”.

(b.) Jesus came into Jerusalem riding a donkey with the people shouting “Hosanna!” This Hebrew word means “Save us, we pray!” We hear this word during Mass, during the blessing of the palms, and during the Palm Sunday procession.
